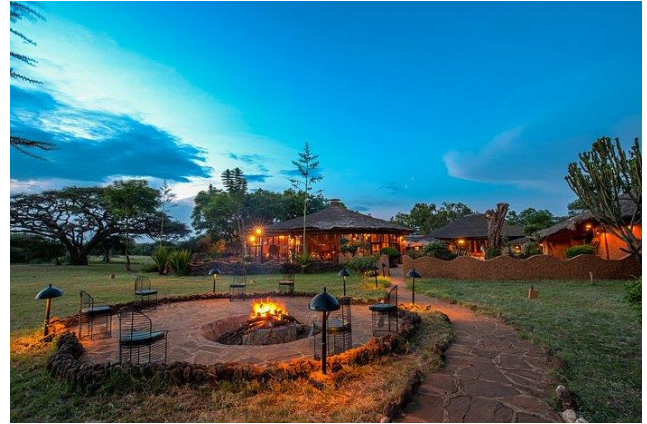

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DAY 1: Nairobi → Amboseli

If you arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in the morning or if you're already staying at a hotel in Nairobi, we'll pick you up by 8:00 a.m. You'll then head to Amboseli National Park, where you'll arrive at your camp in time to settle in before lunch. After some relaxation, you'll set off on an afternoon safari. Amboseli is renowned for its large herds of elephants and the stunning backdrop of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak. Return to your tented camp for dinner and overnight.

DAY 2: Amboseli → Lake Nakuru

After an early breakfast, depart Amboseli for Lake Nakuru, with a brief stop in the spectacular Great Rift Valley. Arrive at Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge for lunch and some free time. Later, depart for an evening safari starting at 4:00 PM. Lake Nakuru is famous for its huge flocks of pink flamingos, as well as its rich flora and fauna. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3: Lake Nakuru → Masai Mara

Cross the Rift Valley to the famous Masai Mara National Reserve. Arrive in time for a late lunch, followed by a short rest and an afternoon game drive. The Masai Mara offers the opportunity to spot the Big Five (lions, leopards, elephants, buffalo, and rhinos), as well as cheetahs, zebras, giraffes, wildebeests, and many others.

DAY 4: Masai Mara

Spend a full day on safari with a picnic lunch on the Mara River. Witness the spectacular wildebeest migration (July to October) and explore the abundant wildlife, including lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, and other Big Five animals.

DAY 5: Masai Mara → Nairobi

After checkout, depart from the Masai Mara. Stop in Narok for last-minute shopping or lunch (own expense). Continue to Nairobi, where you will be transferred back to your hotel, residence, or airport.
