ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – Nairobi → Samburu National Reserve

Your driver-guide will pick you up at your hotel in Nairobi or the airport at 8:00 a.m. After a short briefing, you'll begin your journey north, crossing the lush coffee and pineapple plantations of central Kenya before descending into the semi-arid region of Samburu. You'll arrive at Samburu Shaba Lodge in time for lunch and check-in. In the afternoon, you'll depart for your first safari in the Samburu National Reserve, home to unique northern species such as the reticulated giraffe, Grevy's zebra, Beisa oryx, and the gerenuk. Return to the lodge for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 2 – Full Day in Samburu National Reserve

After breakfast, enjoy a full-day safari to discover the reserve's rugged landscapes and the Ewaso Nyiro River, a veritable lifeline attracting elephants, lions, leopards, and a diverse birdlife. In the afternoon, visit a Samburu cultural village, where you'll discover the rich traditions and way of life of the Samburu people. Return to the lodge for dinner and relaxation under the starry African sky.

DAY 3 – Samburu → Ol Pejeta Conservancy (Sweetwaters)

After breakfast, depart for Ol Pejeta Wildlife Reserve, a 3.5-hour drive through the scenic highlands. Arrive at Sweetwaters Serena Camp in time for lunch and check-in. In the afternoon, depart for a game drive to spot the Big Five, including the endangered black rhino, and visit the Chimpanzee Sanctuary, the only place in Kenya where you can spot chimpanzees. Return to the camp for dinner and overnight, surrounded by views of Mount Kenya.

DAY 4 – Ol Pejeta → Lake Nakuru National Park

Enjoy an early breakfast, then depart for Lake Nakuru National Park, known for its stunning lake views and abundant birdlife. Arrive at Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge for lunch and relaxation. In the afternoon, enjoy a safari to spot flamingos, pelicans, black and white rhinos, giraffes, and perhaps the elusive leopard. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

DAY 5 – Lake Nakuru → Masai Mara National Reserve

After breakfast, depart for the renowned Masai Mara National Reserve, arriving at Zebra Plains Mara Camp in time for lunch.

In the afternoon, depart for your first safari in the Mara, in search of elephants, lions, cheetahs, and other animals on the golden plains. Return to camp for dinner and a free evening.
